## Service Interruption

Greetings Neighbors,

Our infrastructure contractor, Extreme Excavation, is installing a sewer line to serve new homes at 3900 Boulevard Road. The sewer line will pass from Boulevard Road, then down Cedar Park Loop SE, and up Reading Street SE.

Between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Wednesday, April 29, 2026, construction crews may need to **interrupt water service up to two times, lasting as long as one (1) hour each time**. We apologize for the inconvenience.

## Preparing for a planned water outage

Before the water outage:

- Fill pots on the stove with water for cooking.
- Fill potable water containers for drinking. Assume about one gallon of drinking water per person per day.
- Fill a bathtub with water and use buckets to flush toilets. A toilet will flush when approximately a gallon of water is dumped into the bowl.
